Code of Conduct

The following code of conduct applies to all archers, club members, participants, volunteers, coaches, spectators, and guests in order to promote the sport of archery in a fun and safe environment.

The code of conduct is in effect at all club activities and applies to all property, buildings, and staff of the facilities where club activities take place.

1. Respect for all people will be shown at all times.
2. No person shall be under the influence of any substance which may impair the ability to practise archery or participate in club activities safely and in a civilized manner.
3. No belligerent, rude, unruly, threatening, bullying, or aggressive behaviour either verbally, physically, or through other means.
4. No stealing, no damaging, and no tampering with property or equipment.
5. No harassment either verbally, sexually, physically, or through other means.
6. Respect for the rules of archery, proper use of the range and equipment, facilities, the laws of the land, and proper archers etiquette must be shown at all times.

Anyone breaking the code of conduct could be asked to leave the premises immediately without refund and/or face other disciplinary actions.
